CSA Z299 TRAINING WORKSHOP

OBJECTIVE:

This two day course will lead the participants, through active discussion, to a clear understanding of the current interpretation of the Z299 standards. A practical example, with an actual product, is used in a group environment to help the participants determine which Z299 program would apply to sub-suppliers of materials and components using the preferred prescribed method in the CSA standard Z299.0. The workshop concludes with a brief discussion on the future of the Z299 series.
